Greetings of Peace!

Assumption Antipolo, together with the Peace and Care for the Earth Ministry (PACEM), will have its annual culminating activity for stewardship this year dubbed as the Ecology Fair (Eco-Fair) to be held on September 28, 29, 30, 2018 at the basement of the St. Marie Eugenie Sports Complex.

The Eco-Fair, supported by the Assumption Antipolo Family Council Inc. through its Environment and Ecology Committee, will once again coincide with the Fellowship Day activities of the grade levels on September 29 to 30, 2018.

The primary goal of the Eco-Fair is to promote, support and highlight local Filipino environment-friendly products and raise awareness in caring for the Earth. With this, we are inviting all concessionaires who are interested to display and promote their products both for dry-goods and food.

In line with Pope Francis' second encyclical "Laudato Si", which promotes care for the common home, the following are the general guidelines for those interested in participating as concessionaires:

1. No plastic (plastic containers, plastic bags, plastic utensils, PET bottles)
2. Healthy food / organic (No preservatives)
3. Eco-friendly products (no ingredient harmful to the environment) such as herbal products, body care, home care products.
4. Locally, produced or made products-clothes/ shoes / slippers / accessories / bags.

A fee of P1,500 for dry-goods and P2,000 for food concessionaires shall be charged per booth accordingly which covers the whole duration of the fair. We will provide a credit card terminal which can be used by all concessionaires who wish to avail of the service for customer's convenience.




