Dear Parents and Guardians,

With the onset of the rainy season, the Department of Health enjoins everyone to be pro-active in the fight against Dengue Fever. The DOH urges the public to continue to adhere to its 4S Strategy in preventing this dreaded disease.

1. Search and destroy possible breeding grounds of dengue-carrying mosquitoes.
2. Seek early consultation when symptoms like high-grade fever, abdominal pain, rashes and bleeding are observed.
3. Use Self-protective measures like wearing long-sleeved clothing and applying topical mosquito-repellants.
4. Say yes to fogging only when there is an impending Dengue outbreak.

As the school has been doing every year as a precautionary measure against Dengue, your daughters may now come to school in proper Dengue attire. It consists of white long-sleeved shirt with a school patch on the left chest and PE jogging pants or any dark-colored jogging pants for uniformity and adequate coverage. A pair of socks, preferably long, is also advised to be worn. The white long-sleeved shirts are available in the school bookstore.

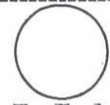
