Dear Parents and Guardians:

Greetings!

Part of the science curriculum of Assumption Antipolo is to provide experiences that would allow the students to appreciate nature and realize the importance of conserving and preserving our natural resources. In line with this objective, the Grade 10 students will have their BIOLOGY TRIP on February 8 and 9, 2018 (Thursday and Friday). The venue of the said trip will be at Camayan Beach in Subic Bay, Zambales.

This is an interdisciplinary activity integrated with other subject areas like Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE), Alay Kapwa at Kalikasan (AKK), Araling Panlipunan, and Health. A fee of Php 2, 650 which was included in the Grade 10 tuition was collected from each student. This amount will cover all the expenses such as the bus/toll fee, the park entrance fee, and miscellaneous expenses.

The following are the things that the students need to bring:

- Tent and grill (per group)
- Aqua shoes or old sneakers
- AA swimsuit and board shorts
- Rash guard or leggings and long-sleeved shirt
- Snorkel and mask (optional)
- Sun block, mosquito/insect repellent, petroleum jelly
- Underwater camera or underwater case for camera (1 per group)
- Snacks, lunch (placed in recyclable/reusable containers), water for drinking
- Trash bag (2 per section: biodegradable for leftovers and non-biodegradable)
- Personal medicines
- Toiletries including a hand sanitizer
- Towel, extra clothes
- Cap

The trip is an overnight activity, and the group is expected to leave the school at exactly 4:00 AM on February 8, 2018. They are expected to arrive at Assumption Antipolo on February 9, 2018 at 4:00 PM. For security reasons, all students will only be picked up at Assumption Antipolo.

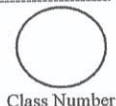




