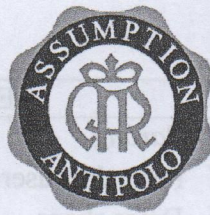

Cost of dress, hair and makeup, and accessories: **maximum PhP 8,000**; receipts to be submitted.



We send you our deepest gratitude for all the support you have been giving us. We believe that with your help, this event will be what we have always dreamed it to be. May God continue to bless you and your family!




