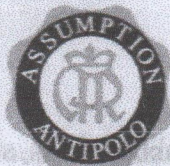


Please take note of the following:

- Others: Students who are prone to motion sickness are advised to take medication and to bring barf bags.


Please be reminded that the pick-up and drop-off points are strictly at Assumption Antipolo.
