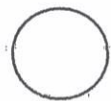
The following are the things that the students need to bring:




